

**James Frederick Meaden
1918-1992**

**Doris Kathleen Shrubsole
1915-1955**

JAMES FREDERICK (FRED) was born at 80 Clarence Street Landport 4th May 1918 and was baptised 11th February 1920. He attended St Agatha's Boys School.

When he left school he worked for the Portsmouth EVENING NEWS, in the dispatch department. He also worked in the mornings for UNITED DAIRYS crating up the milk bottles.

FRED married DORIS KATHLEEN (DOT) SHRUBSOLE in the JULY-SEPT quarter of 1940.

DOT was born 18th July 1915, daughter of ARTHUR EDWARD and MABEL SHRUBSOLE at 6 Bakers Street Landport. She was baptised 1st August 1915 at All Saints Church Landport.

By 1946 they were living with FRED'S mother at 16 Nelson Road Landport, and were there until 1951 when they went to live at 5 Malins Road Landport. By this time DOT had already given birth to two daughters, SANDRA KAY and GILLIAN WENDY.

SANDRA married a DAVID HILL and GILLIAN married MICHAEL (MICK) WHITE.

GILLIAN and MICK had two sons DARREN and NATHAN.
DARREN married on 31st OCT 1992

DOT died of cancer in the (OCT-DEC) QUARTER 1955 aged 40. FRED continued to look after the girls until they married.

Soon after the girls were married they decided they would emigrate to NEW ZEALAND and start a family. DAVID worked as a Technical Officer in AUCKLAND DOCKYARD. Both families lived in AUKCLAND, but I have no knowledge as to MICKS occupation.

When FRED retired he also went to NEW ZEALAND and lived the rest of his life with SANDRA and her family. TERRY informs me that during his visits to FRED, when he was in the Navy, FRED was having treatment for cancer. FRED died in 1992, he was 74.
